Answer Key

Question	Correct Response	Explanation	Rule
Q1	A	Traditional and Hybrid events use FTC-Live as the event management software.	
Q2	B	FTC-Live does not require a new installation download on each release. If an internet connection is present, each time the software is launched it will automatically determine if an update is available and downloads/applies the update to the installed software.	
Q3	B	The scoring system does not officially support Firefox. The recommended browser to run the scoring system is Google Chrome.	
Q4	A	True. This local administrator account can only be logged into from the scoring server running the FTC-Live application. Logging in from a remote computer requires different login credentials.	
Q5	A	Events that do not originate from within the Event Dashboard of the FTC Scoring cloud-based system cannot take advantage of cloud-based features during the event like FTC-Events updates and Remote Pit Displays.	
Q6	E, F	The Scrimmage event type is used for unofficial events during the regular competition season, and the Offseason event type is used for unofficial events outside of the regular competition season.	
Q7	A	Cloud-based FTC Scoring (https://ftc-scoring.firstinspires.org).	
Q8	A	All teams must be checked in and team eligibility has been confirmed prior to creating match schedules.	
Q9	B	Practice matches are for teams, test matches for training event staff (Scorekeeper, Referee, etc.) and hardware testing.	
Q10	B	The state of each match is recorded by referees using score input tablets.	
Q11	B, D, E	Event setup is performed through the Event Dashboard, as is Adding/Removing/Editing teams.	
Q12	A	The IP address is what's used to access the server from a remote machine using a supported web browser.	
Q13	A	This will still show the match timer on displays with a match timer, but updates to the real-time scores will no longer show on the Audience Display or Championship Bar.	
Q14	A	The tablets must also be on the same network as the FTC-Live server and have unrestricted access (no firewalls).	
Q15	E	All of these roles have functions within FTC-Live	
Q16	A	Updates/Edits to attending teams in FTC-Live is reflected in FTC-Events once the event syncs. Once the event is transferred from the Cloud-Based FTC Scoring system to FTC-Live, edits should no longer be made to the event in the FTC Scoring system.	

Q17	C	Options A and B do not exist. While it's true that some display options can be changed from the Settings tab, Option C (Video Switch) is the most appropriate answer.	
Q18	A	Awards are presented via the "Present Awards" tab within the Match Control Page once the awards have been entered into FTC-Live by the judges or imported into FTC-Live from FTC Scoring.	
Q19	B	In order to publish a traditional or hybrid event, the Scorekeeper must press the "Send Results to <i>FIRST</i> " button. Do not do this prior to announcing awards or else the awards will also be made public!	
Q20	A	For leagues, event results and rankings are not finalized in FTC-Events until the event is published using the "Publish Event Results" button in the Event Dashboard.
